Two kinds of influenza vaccinations are now available. One is a combination vaccine for both the new strain of flu (H1N1) and seasonal flu, and the other is a vaccine for the new strain only. You can choose between the two.

Subsidies are available for those who are between 1 and 12 years of age, those who are 65 years of age or older, and expectant mothers if vaccinations are received at registered medical institutions in the 23 cities of Tokyo. 
